Unlike some of Alfred Hitchock's other leading ladies, Shirley MacLaine became an offscreen companion, and he took her for breakfast every day before shooting. He never propositioned her, but thought of her as "a girl who needed to be fed." Having just been plucked from the poverty-stricken life of a Broadway chorus girl, it was a pleasant change for MacLaine. As a result, she gained fifteen pounds during shooting, resulting in a phone call from the studio telling her to stop eating so much, as she was going to "ruin her career before it had even begun."



During filming, cinematographer Milton R. Krasner pointed out to Cary Grant that a lump on his forehead was making it hard to film his close-ups. The lump was the result of a childhood accident, but Grant had been habitually rubbing it for years, leading it to swell. Doctors told him it would take four to six weeks for him to recover from its removal. Instead, he took a few days off, had his wife, Betsy Drake, hypnotize him, and had the procedure performed in the doctor's office under a local anesthetic. He recovered within days with no scarring


